Michael Seal currently holds the position of Associate Conductor of the City of Birmingham Symphony Orchestra (CBSO).

Michael has worked with many of the UK's finest orchestras, as guest conductor with the BBC Symphony, BBC Philharmonic, Royal Philharmonic, Royal Liverpool Philharmonic and Ulster orchestras, as well as the BBC Concert Orchestra, BBC National Orchestra of Wales, BBC Scottish Symphony Orchestra, Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra and London Philharmonic Orchestra.

Internationally, he has conducted the Frankfurt Radio Symphony Orchestra, KBS Symphony Orchestra, Norwegian Radio Orchestra, Odense Symphony Orchestra, Joensuu City Orchestra, Orquesta Académica del Instituto Superior de Arte del Teatro Colón, Orquesta Filarmónica de Buenos Aires and both RTÉ Concert and National Symphony Orchestras.

Michael has a special bond with the CBSO Youth Orchestra, having been involved with it since its foundation. He is also Artistic Advisor and Conductor for the CBSO Youth Orchestra Academy.

2016-17 engagements include several appearances with the CBSO, plus return visits to the BBC Philharmonic, Royal Liverpool Philharmonic, London Philharmonic, Bournemouth Symphony and Orquesta Académica del Instituto Superior de Arte del Teatro Colón.

Auditions For UYO

Applications are invited from instrumentalists aged between 14 and 23 years on 10th August 2017. Applicants should be of a standard equivalent to Grade 7/8 Associated Board. Promising players who have not yet reached this standard are also encouraged to apply. Applications are particularly welcome from oboe, bassoon, tuba, cello and double bass players.

Applications will be accepted from musicians born, resident or studying in Northern Ireland, however, consideration will be given to other applicants at the discretion of the board to ensure the necessary orchestral balance.

Auditionees will be required to play two contrasting pieces of their own choice, a selection of prepared orchestral excerpts and some unseen excerpts to sight-read on the day.

A non-refundable audition registration fee of £20.00 is required before an audition can be scheduled. Please make cheques payable to "Ulster Youth Orchestra".

The membership fee covers all course fees plus free entry to other education events such as open rehearsals with the Ulster Orchestra, our annual Play-in Day and more to be announced!

Auditions will be scheduled on 22nd and 23rd December, 2016 and will take place in the City of Belfast School of Music, Fortwilliam Park, Belfast.

Applicants are encouraged to apply to their local council and school or college for financial assistance. A Bursary Fund is available for students who are in financial need and are unsuccessful in their applications to the above. Further details are available from the General Manager.
